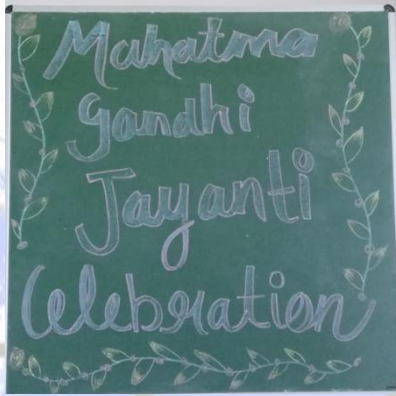

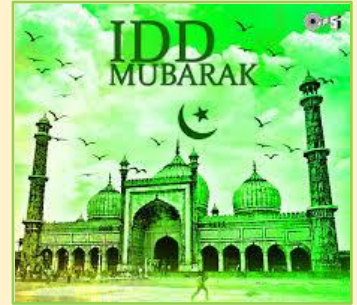
Indian Air force Day Celebration

A special assembly was conducted by the students of TNRSG. The importance and history of the Air Force was presented which motivated students to serve the country as a future fighter.



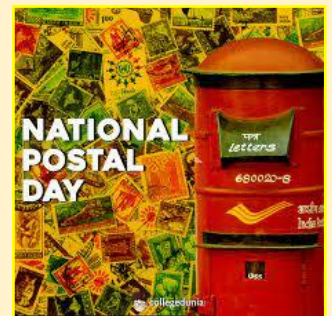
Eid-e-Milad Celebration

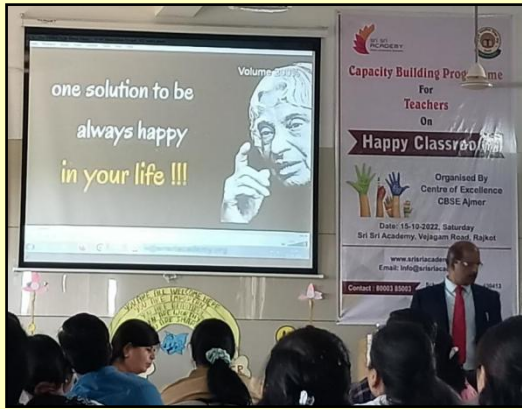

Happy Classroom Training

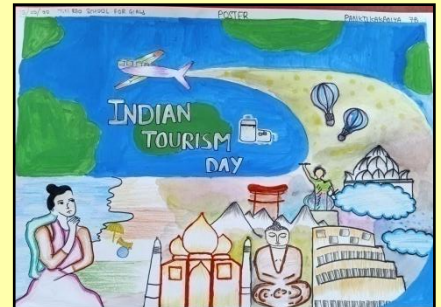
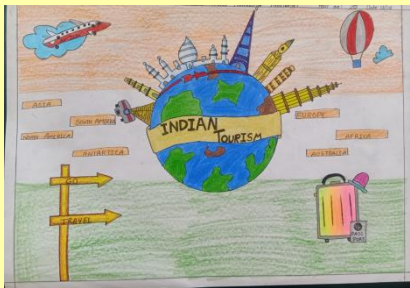
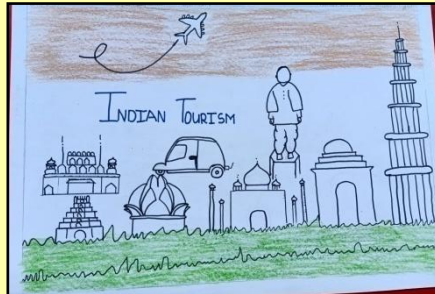

Participation in CBSE EXPRESSION SERIES: 'Tourism in India'

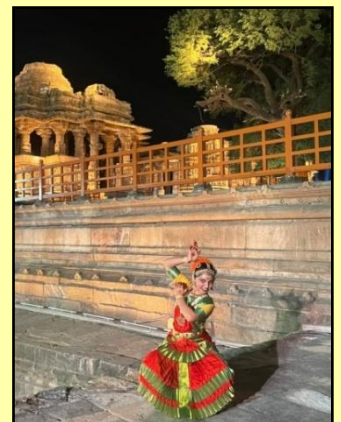
Student-Enrichment activities conducted by the Board for the academic session 2022-23 is Vision for India. TNRSG students participated for the same.

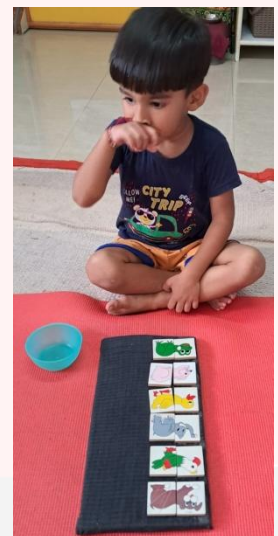

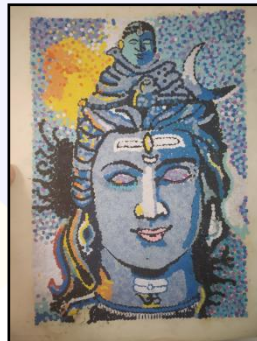

Life Skill

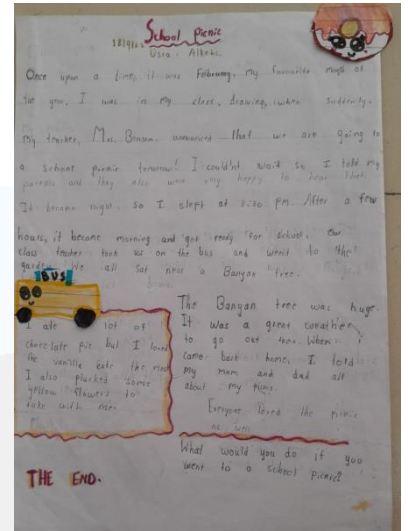
In the context of 'World Mental Health Day' a life skill session on Thoughts, Feelings and Behaviours and their interconnection was held for students of class 9th.
